The first woman and second person to receive a doctorate in flute performance from The Juilliard School, flutist Jan Vinci earned a master's in music from The Cleveland Institute of Music and a bachelor's in music from Bowling Green State University. She studied with Julius Baker, Samuel Baron, Maurice Sharp, Judith Bentley and Martha Aarons. Vinci is Senior Artist-in-Residence at Skidmore College in Saratoga Springs, NY and formerly served on the faculties of Aaron Copland School of Music at Queens College and Hofstra University. For 16 years, Ms. Vinci has directed and taught master classes at the Skidmore Summer Flute Institute, and for more than a decade has presented an annual Skidmore Flute Festival. She served as President of the New York Flute Club.

In celebration of the opening of the Arthur Zankel Music Center at Skidmore College, Senior Artists-in-Residence Jan Vinci and pianist Pola Baytelman commissioned award-winning composer Jennifer Higdon to write a sonata for flute and piano, to receive its world premiere in November, 2010 at the Zankel Center's gala dedication program. A virtuosic and tonally rich sonata, Higdon's *Flute Poetic* gives flute and piano equal importance, challenge and prominence, and is the cornerstone of an exciting performance and recording project conceived by Vinci and Baytelman. Individually acclaimed for their solo careers, the two performers are collaborating with gusto, developing a program of depth, intrigue and delight, featuring works by American composers. Utilizing Higdon's new composition as a springboard, the artists' program includes duo and solo works that reveal the multi-faceted tonal colors and musical possibilities of their instruments.
